Don't miss another great opportunity to view Ontario's magnificent Fall colours, already on the way to Parry Sound. Usually, as soon as you pass Mount St. Louis-Moonstone and onto the "Canadian Shield", you will notice the change in scenery, both rock formations and in foliage as we enter the northern hardwood forests.

The Bay Street Café is situated right on the harbour of Parry Sound which will afford us a nice view of the water, perhaps the weather will be good enough to sit outside even?

We board the Island Queen at 12:45 p.m. The Queen is a 550 passenger ship specially designed for cruising the 30,000 Islands, with maneuverability and a shallow draft to allow easy access to narrow channels and amazing up-close opportunities for photographing the beautiful scenery. It provides spacious and comfortable heated inner seating, large viewing windows and outside observation decks for a captain's-eye view of the islands.

With its spectacular glacier-smoothed islands of ancient Precambrian rock, its tenacious twisted pines, its secluded beaches of golden sand and its dramatic granite cliffs, Georgian Bay's Thirty Thousand Islands region is one of Canada's most breathtaking geographic areas. Now part of the new United Nations designated Georgian Bay Littoral Biosphere Reserve, this part of Georgian Bay is remarkable not only in its natural beauty but also in its history, geology and wildlife.
