This innocent comedy stars Paul Hörbiger in the role of "Jäger" Kasper Brandner, with Carl Wery, Ursula Lingen, Georg Thomalla, Victor Staal, Gustav Waldau among others; Producer Josef von Baky.

As "Vorspann" we will show a nature film, a film about one of Austria's many national parks, "Nationalpark Nockberge". One of Austria's oldest landscapes is a green island surrounded by young, dramatic peaks. The gently onndulating hills are reminiscent of Irleland and the high plateaus of Castille. In Summer, herds of red deer running into the hundreds, share the pastures with domestic cows in harmony, grazing right up to the mountain tops. Old mines have long been overgrown by Alpine forests. Wild nature and the ancient culture of the mountain farmers are imprinted upon this National Park of the "Nockberge", which in the middle of Austria encompasses an almost exotic landscape.
