Welcome back to the new Season 2012/2013 and we hope that you all had a beautiful and restful summer. The Board of Directors has set the dates for this new season's events and we enclose the programme for events planned.

We will commence the new season with a film evening:

If you intend to dine prior to the movie please come early so that we can begin

the feature presentation punctually at 8:00 p.m.

For the "Vorspann" we have selected a documentary on the Alps, a natural history of this mountain range, "Die Alpen – Im Reich des Steinadlers". A 1,200 km long chain of rocky peaks form the most famous of mountain ranges in the world. They rise at Nice from the Mediterranean Sea to peaks of ten thousand feet and curve across the middle of Europe to gently fade into the hills south of Vienna. Between the Côte d'Azure and the Kahlenberg a fascinating world opens up to the eye, familiar for its peaks and surprising in their natural diversity. The film presents the mountains and all their life forms from unknown and most surprising vantage points. Due to its length, however, we may be able to show only the first part of this beautiful documentary with the second half to follow at a future film evening.

As the main feature we will bring

#### "DER DRITTE MANN"

We are certain that most of you will remember this classic post-war film by Carol Reed, with a stellar cast of Orson Wells as Harry Lime, Joseph Cotton, Paul Hörbiger, Alida Valli, the ultimate British actor Trevor Howard, among many others. Last but not least, everyone will remember the Zithermotive of the film by Anton Karas, which has become famous around the world. The story takes place in the Vienna of 1948: The American writer Holly Martins is looking for his old friend Harry Lime, however, on the day of his arrival Lime is being buried. Martins is told by a British officer that Lime had been an unscrupulous black marketer.

Martin does not believe this and with the help of Lime's lover, Anna, who had fled the Russian Sector, he attempts to find out the truth. This search draws him deeper and deeper into the labyrinth of a world of corruption, deceit and murder. Finally his search for "The Third Man" takes him into the depths of the underground maze of sewer systems of the City of Vienna..... You will just have to see the ending yourself. It is one of the most accomplished thrillers of all times but never gets old!
